### WELCOME TO THIS QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION

#### Q 350 “ THE DIVINE POWER STATION”

*Prof. Anil Kumar Kamaraju was chosen by Bhagawan to spread His Message and Mission. He has travelled extensively in India and abroad and has answered countless questions and cleared doubts based on Swami’s Divine discourses and his personal interactions with Bhagawan. Most importantly, Prof. Anil Kumar guides us effectively on how to connect to the Inner Sai.*

**Q. What are the advantages of Mahasamadhi Darshan? (Experiencing the spiritual blessings of Baba at His sacred tomb?)**

**A. Prof. Anil Kumar:** So, you want to know the advantages of *Mahasamadhi* Darshan. Well, do you know about the Machkund power project, which supplies power or electricity to the whole state? If anything goes wrong in Machkund, there is a power-cut. We then live in total darkness, as all power comes from there. Likewise, the *Mahasamadhi* is a power project or a thermal station and the current of Divine blessings flows continuously from there. From this Mahasamadhi, grace, benediction, mercy and compassion flow. That is one benefit.

Another is *Kalpavriksha*, the wish-fulfilling tree. There was such a tree here once. People went there, meanwhile forgetting Baba Himself. We wanted to see the tree, but not Baba, because we have so many wishes and they have to be fulfilled there. That tree fell down recently and now we have no *Kalpavriksha* tree anymore. I look at it this way: From now on, the *Mahasamadhi* is the *Kalpavriksha*. There at the Mahasamadhi, all our desires and all our aspirations are fulfilled.

We have yet another advantage or benefit from the *Mahasamadhi* darshan. If you look at the Samadhi, you will see that it is made from white marble stone with a gold border on all sides. On His birthday, Baba wears white and His dhoti has a gold border. The *Mahasamadhi* is an ever-vibrant birthday dress, because every day is the Birthday of Bhagawan.

You must have heard of these particular gods: Sri Ranganatha Swami, Mohana Ranganayaka Swami, Sri Mahavishnu and Anantha Padmanabha Murthi. They are always shown in the reclining posture.

So now we also have Sai Ranga, Sri Sathya Sai Panduranga Bhagawan, resting in Samadhi, giving blessings and darshan to everybody. That is how I look at it.

***Q. Swami is always with us. In fact, He is Antharyami. We all know that through our personal experiences. So why, at times, do we miss His physical form? We really miss Him and cry. Why?***

**A. Prof. Anil Kumar:** It is because so far in our life we have been used to talking to Him, and we have been used to passing letters to Him and having interviews. We've been used to presenting flowers to Him. Now that the physical proximity has gone, we feel sad, but we will very soon overcome that feeling by His Divine Grace.

***Q. Sometimes it is painful to think that Swami is not in His physical form. Please give us some realistic advice on how to get over this. You mentioned stories which have happened in the past. Do you know of any experiences which devotees have had in the recent past, after Swami physically left us?***

**A. Prof. Anil Kumar:** Don't feel sorry about His physical withdrawal from the body. Instead feel the presence of Sai. Whenever you sing His glory, whenever you read His literature, whenever you participate in any service activity, whenever you love, whenever you are giving and forgiving – there is Sai! You are Sai! Sai and you are one, forever and ever.

My friends, believe me or not, today more miracles are happening than ever before. Earlier, very few miracles happened in Puttaparthi. We fellows here learned about your experiences and spoke everywhere about them. But today, more miracles are happening in Prasanthi Nilayam. Perhaps He thought we needed some more 'medical treatment' or even 'surgery', I do not know. That's how I take it.

Never before have so many miracles happened here as are happening today. In the South Indian canteen on the wall, there are Swami's footprints. In the South Indian canteen on the ladies side, close to the storeroom, there has been a continuous flow of *amrit* on Swami's picture for the last one month.

*Vibhuti* is pouring out from one of the photos in the North Block or Round Block. In the village of Puttaparthi, *amrit* is flowing from the feet of a statue of Swami, which was made by a Muslim, and *vibhuti* is pouring from the head as well.

Sathya Sai Baba is the eternal, immortal, blemishless God. He is Divinity incarnated forever and ever more!

***Q. I have one question. It is of a personal nature. Did you ever imagine that the part you would play in the Sai mission would be much greater today when he is no longer physically here, than when you were the translator and you were closest to Him? Personally, do you feel that today our role is actually much more important as His emissaries, rather than when He was physically present here?***

**A. Prof. Anil Kumar:** My friends, believe me, I feel the need to meet the devotees all over the world. I feel the need to go around the villages, towns and cities in India and tell devotees that Swami has not left us. He is with us. Don't cry and don't change your political parties. Religion is not politics, so don't be carried away by rumours and don't listen to TV channels and newspapers. That is nothing but cooked-up information.

Establish yourself in your faith. **Sai is with you.** These are the things I want to tell everyone. So, given the chance, I don't want to rest for even a day. I want to travel forever and ever, to give more courage and faith to the devotees of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba.

**Q. *Since Swami is everywhere, is there any need to go to Puttaparthi?***

**A. Prof. Anil Kumar:** If God is everywhere, then why do you go to the temple? You can sleep in any room, so why do you need a bedroom? You can cook on the veranda or in the street, so why do you need a kitchen?

Baba is everywhere. He is like the current, which exists everywhere all at once. His energy and power are omnipresent. But Puttaparthi is like a thermal power station. It is like a power station from which the energy is sent forth into the world. And so you come here. You come to be near that source of Divine energy.
